SKAPS Industries Selects NSC Nonwoven Equipment

France-based NSC nonwoven has received a contract from Athens, Ga.-based SKAPS Industries - a manufacturer of geosynthetic and nonwoven drainage products for environmental and civil use — under which NSC will supply needlepunching equipment for the production of geotextiles and other products. This is the second line SKAPS has purchased from NSC nonwoven within the last three years. Equipment includes a Thibeau Excelle® batt formation machine with IsoProDyn®, the new A.C.S. system for high-speed crosslapping, and three Asselin® needlepunch looms.

According to NSC nonwoven, the new line will offer high production volume while minimizing weight variation and improving fiber orientation to provide consistent strength properties. The equipment will be installed at SKAPS' facility in Athens. NSC USA in Fort Mill, S.C., will provide all after-sales service and support.
